Allen R. Matthews Award

Mr. George R. Ryan, Jr., Director of Test and Evaluation and Standards, U.S. Department of Homeland Security

The Allen R. Matthews Award was established in honor of ITEA's founder. The award is presented to an individual for a lasting, significant contribution to the field of T&E, such as the cumulative effect of a distinguished career. It is the highest award bestowed by ITEA.

Special Achievement Award

Mr. Reed Robinson, Shootable Remote Threat Ground Target Project, Naval Air Weapons Center - Weapons & Energetics Department, China Lake

The Special Achievement Award recognizes a recent outstanding achievement in test and evaluation engineering, technology, or management such as the solution of a major problem, or a notable project success for which there is evidence that tangible benefits have accrued.

Technical Achievement Award (Modeling and Simulation)

The 2005 Technical Achievement Award recognizes a recent outstanding achievement of applying Test Instrumentation in a test and evaluation program that caused the program to be executed better, faster, and cheaper.

Richard G. Cross Award

The Cross Award was established in honor of the late Major General Richard G. Cross, Jr., USAF (Ret), one of the most highly respected individuals in the field of test and evaluation in the 20th century. Publication Award
